

IMMERSIVE LEARNING

An effective way to learn a language is by completing a task with a fluent speaker. A teacher and learner can interact in the language while cooking, doing laundry, or shopping.

What you will need: A language teacher (negotiate a fair fee), activity at an offsite location (ex. making bannock at the community centre), ingredients (\$25.00) = **total varies**



Step 1) Do some community research to find a suitable Indigenous language teacher.

Step 2) Ask the language teacher what an appropriate fee would be to conduct a 2-hour hands-on workshop.

Step 3) Complete a budget proposal that includes language teacher fee, activity costs (venue rental, materials), proposed date and time, and mileage.

Step 4) Once the budget and project proposals are approved, complete the invitations and post in the community flyer or on social media.

Step 5) A few days before the event, purchase or collect the necessary programming materials.

Step 6) Run the program on the designated date and time. Note any changes while observing the program.

Activity takes approximately 2 hours.
