

Library donations are often well-intentioned gifts. Posting a short but informative donation guideline at your desk or in the library can alleviate the extra work involved in sorting a donation. It is good practice to have a donation policy in your collections management policy.

WHAT MAKES A GOOD LIBRARY DONATION?

Due to limited space, the library cannot take all donations. Should you wish to donate, we ask that you follow these guidelines:

- Materials must be in good condition
- Materials should be current
- The following items are not accepted:
 - Textbooks
 - Books in a poor physical condition
 - Out-of-date nonfiction
 - VHS tapes
- Books written by Indigenous authors will be accepted regardless of age.
- Books written about Indigenous people by non-Indigenous authors will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- Please take all unwanted donations with you for proper disposal.
